- Many pharmacies now offer a 30-day supply of most generic prescription drugs for \$4.
- Many of these same pharmacies also offer a 90-day supplies for \$10.
- Publix pharmacies offer seven prescription antibiotics at NO COST to you.

By utilizing these retail programs, you can reduce your prescription drug co-pay costs and help UMPH lower our medical costs as well.
